- Apply for enrollment into a program.
- Successfully complete [state-approved teacher preparation coursework for option 3](#).
- Meet basic skills requirements of the [WV Licensure Testing Directory](#).
- Meet content requirements of the [WV Licensure Testing Directory](#) for the specific endorsement(s) sought.
- Meet professional education requirements of the [WV Licensure Testing Directory](#) for the endorsement(s) sought.
- Apply for WV Provisional Teaching Certificate with [WVDE Certification Services](#).
