	Meet coursework option specific requirements if they exist (e.g. some coursework options require a valid substitute teaching permit and/or a minimum GPA of 2.75).
	Apply for enrollment into a program.
	Complete any endorsement (content) specific trainings required by the WVDE program you are participating in (e.g., the endorsements of Biology 9-Adult, Chemistry 9-Adult, Chemistry/Physics 9-Adult, Earth & Space Science 5-Adult, General Science 5-9 or 5-Adult, Physics 9-Adult may require additional lab-based training(s) prior to being officially recommended for licensure).
	Successfully complete a <u>state-approved WVDE Alternative Certification program</u> including meeting all requirements of the specific coursework option.
	Meet professional education requirements of the <u>WV Licensure Testing Directory</u> for the endorsement(s) sought.
	<u>Request</u> and receive an approved rating on the Comprehensive Evaluation Report if one is required by the program, as described on the WVDE website.
	Apply for WV Provisional Teaching Certificate with <u>WVDE Certification Services.</u>
