



BECOME A CTE TEACHER IN WEST VIRGINIA



STEP 1

SKILLS VERIFICATION and/or DEGREE

Verify your degree and/or your wage-earning work experience in accordance with the requirements outlined in the CTE Endorsement and Testing Manual. Once confirmed, register for the CTE Educator Prep Program. For more information and to register for courses, visit teachwv.com.



STEP 2

EMPLOYABILITY TESTING

Contact your local school district and register to take the NOCTI Employability Exam. This exam measures the skills needed for success in the workplace and covers reading, math, collaboration, and decision making. STEP 3

CTE MENTORSHIP

During your first year of teaching, you will be required to complete a mentorship program hosted by a WVDE Coordinator. The mentorship program will include in-person collaborative trainings, classroom visits, virtual discussions, and individualized support.



STEP 4

CTE CERTIFICATION

Depending on your Program of Study, you may be required to take the NOCTI Content and Performance Assessment and/or hold the required industry credential per the CTE Endorsement and Testing Manual. Please refer to the [NOCTI website](#) for testing blueprints.
